4. Legal Basis for Data Processing

The personal datas are managed by our Company according to the related legal provisions and in the following cases:

- conclusion, prolongation or possible termination of a contract between Cilent and the Company (thus on contractual basis),
- in case of lack of contractual basis, the data may be managed based on the so-called legitimate interest opinion. Handling data and contact details of our business partners (name, position) for business purposes is in the interest of our Company, therefore in such cases the legal basis for handling data is our Company's legitimate interest.

It is also possible to manage data:

- if it is required by law,
- or with the consent of the data subject.

5. What are the purposes of managing personal data?

6. How long does the Company store personal data?

Personal data of business partners will be stored until the termination of the business relationship and for 96 months after the last business contact between the Company and Client.

In case of termination of the agreement between Client and the Company for any reason personal data of business partners will be managed according to the Point 7B.

8. What are your rights and remedies?

You:

- > you may request information about data handling.
- > from the stored personal data you can request a copy, and you may transfer it to other data managers.
- > Modification, correction, addition of the personal data can be requested
- > you may object against data handling or request deletion or limitation of your personal data (with the exception of mandatory data handling).

In case of violation of rights:

- > You have legal remedies in Court of Law (The Court will proceed with priority. Data protection cases fall into the competence of the Tribunal Court, legal proceedings can be in the Tribunal of your address or place of residence.)
- May complain at the supervisory authority (Hungarian National Authority for Data Protection and Freedom of Information; 1125 Budapest, Szilágyi Erzsébet fasor 22/c).

9. What else you need to know about our personal data management?

Our company manage your personal data with your consent during our business relationship.

You are entitled to withdraw your consent to manage your personal data anytime with an unilateral written statement.
